



## Restoration Project Update

The week of September 23, 2013, we are pleased to report that St. Francis of Assisi will be commencing the renovations to the front west stairs of the parish, the replacement and restoration of the lanterns and the re-installation of the north perimeter fence. We are hopeful that the renovations will be completed by late fall.

During the construction, the west stairs will be closed and parishioners and visitors will have access to the church through the doors on the south west corner. As the work progresses, you will see the removal of existing concrete stairs and metal handrail; installation of the new concrete landing and stairs with new foundations; installation of new metal handrails; installation of refurbished lanterns at each stone side wall; repair of stone side walls and the missing portion of fence on the north side of the church will be replaced with new black chain link fencing.

Through the tendering process for the first phase of the project, Buttcon Limited is the successful General Contractor and will be performing the work to our front stairs.

The next phase of the restoration will be the renovations to the rectory and the parish. The tendering process for the next phase will occur mid-September.
