ONGOING PIPE ORGAN MAINTENANCE WORK

If you have a keen ear, you will have noticed the gradual improvements being made on our pipe organ. During November and December additional work is being undertaken to slowly bring the organ back to its pristine condition. Next year this instrument will be 100 years old! We hope to have the trumpets and oboes of the organ sounding again in time for Christmas. These 2 sets of pipes/ranks of the organ have not functioned since about 1992. Also, we have made arrangements to have the organ covered – the construction dust and the condition of the plaster ceiling above it are causing it some distress – but it will still be used to accompany our worship.

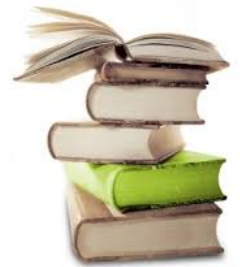

Nonostante ciò l'organo continuerà ad accompagnare le nostre Liturgie.
