### OUR LADY OF LOURDES WORLD DAY OF THE SICK FEB 11<sup>TH</sup> GIORNATA MONDIALE DEL MALATO



The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11 (memorial of our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.

At the morning Mass this Wed Feb 11<sup>th</sup> we will administer the Sacrament of the Sick to our parishioners who seek the comfort of this sacrament – those who are ill and in recent years the invitation has also been extended to our elderly.

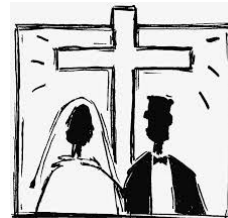
### VOLUNTEERS FOR PREPPING COSTUMES

Last year for the same period, i.e. Nov 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 to Jan 31<sup>st</sup> 2014, heating expenses were a total of **\$4,773.21**.

## LA QUINTA DOMENICA DEL TEMPO ORDINARIO – ANNO B – 8 FEBBRAIO 2015

### WHAT HAS BEEN DONE TO THE ORGAN? LAVORI SULL'ORGANO DELLA CHIESA

Vi presentiamo un elenco dei lavori sull'organo della chiesa. Lasciamo l'elenco in inglese pero vogliamo informarvi che stiamo cercando di salvaguardare il patrimonio della comunità. Notate bene... mancano altre tappe in questo cammino di cura.

We have been slowly attending to the needs of our 100 year old pipe organ. As we examine our records, it seems that the last time major maintenance work was done on it was 35 years ago. In this past little while we have worked on the following:

- ✓ Organ Blower (mechanical motor that supplies the organ with wind/air) was serviced. The motor was lubricated, filter cleaned and checked flexible wind connection and pressure
- ✓ Installation of new leather rings and leather tops (surfaces) to all manual (keyboard) valves of the GREAT and SWELL divisions of the organ. This had to be done to prevent dead notes. the surface of the valves had eroded and developed a sticky surface resulting in valves sticking together and not permitting the air to reach the desired pipe(s)
- ✓ Re-attached loose ivories on the manuals (keyboards)
- ✓ Greased or oiled certain mechanical parts of the organ
- ✓ Repaired damaged or loose contacts on the organs (manual/keyboard) action
- ✓ Missing or damaged pipes where either replaced or repaired (a total of 10 pipes/notes)
- ✓ Mechanical repairs or adjustments on the manuals/action (the keyboards)
- ✓ Complete tuning of all pipes (a total of 1,198 pipes)
- ✓ Patched damaged leather to approx. 14 valves on the PEDAL division (the Bourdon Stop) of the organ
- ✓ Cleaning and tuning of the reed pipes of the organ, the Oboes and Trumpets. A total 130 pipes (65 pipes to each rank or set) were carefully removed from the organ, dismantled, cleaned, reassembled and reinstalled in the organ. These stops had not worked since about 1992 (some 22 years)
- ✓ Covered the top of the organ temporarily to protect the instrument from ceiling debris and dust (it doesn't look covered but it is...we have basically put a temporary roof over the top of the organ... Brides should appreciate this approach for their wedding photographs.

TOTAL Spent (to date) reviving the organ: \$8,800.00 + HST  
Please note that this is a first step. There is more work that needs to be completed.
