WHO IS WILLING TO ACCOMPANY THESE INQUIRERS?

You may be aware that we have had a number of special moments here at St Francis. In December we had five adults who were fully initiated into the Church and in the past couple of weeks we had three more adults who were baptized outside the Catholic Church ask for full admittance to the Church. Their baptisms are recognized as valid but the welcoming ceremony asks that they make a profession of the Catholic Faith, and then receive the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.

It would not be surprising if we found ourselves preparing others once the autumn rolls around.
